Export Report: MS-Access database / HTML / Comma Separated Values (CSV), Portable Document Format (PDF), MS-Excel (XLS) and TIFF file format. Data exportable into MS-Access database for archival purposes or import into Microsoft Excel for further analysis.

Publish Report: Publish reports to a document library and share the reports with the respective users.

E-mail Report: E-mail reports to internal SharePoint users in the organization.

Preview and Print Report: Flexible print preview and print options to print the reports from SharePoint Farm Reporter to any local / network printer.
